Dr. Joseph Gerson has served the American Friends Service committee since 1976 and is currently Director of Programs and Director of the Peace and Economic Security Program for the AFSC-NE. He focuses on challenging and overcoming U.S. global hegemony.

He has spoken extensively worldwide and is author of several books, including *Empire and the Bomb: How the US Uses Nuclear Weapons to Dominate the World*. Gerson is currently coordinating an international network organizing a call for the Non Proliferation Treaty Review Conference to launch negotiations for a treaty to abolish nuclear weapons worldwide.
