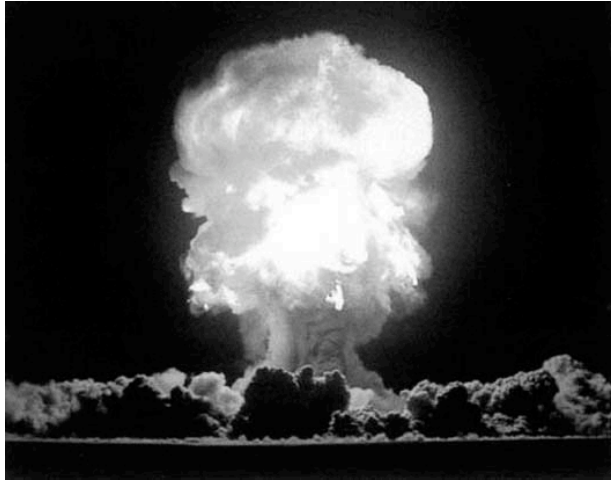


What is the ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT OF WAR?
