

White House/Pentagon Lies and the Afghan War Today

UNH Professor Marc Herold has done a systematic study of civilian deaths and other aspects of the US-led war against Al-Qaeda and the Taliban in Afghanistan. He has consistently pointed to uncomfortable, underreported facts. Obama administration reports from Afghanistan are often sheer propaganda. As far as the Afghans are concerned, it has become a war of national liberation, which means that any chance for US/NATO victory is over. Professor Herold concludes with a consideration of the politics of how US wars end.

Marc Herold is a professor of economic development at the University of NH. He has published widely on Third World development matters. In December 2001, he published the widely acclaimed dossier on Afghan civilian casualties caused by the 2001 US bombing. He has published close to 100 articles on the Afghan war.
