In 1914, WWI, the bloodiest war yet, was under way. However on Christmas Eve, sections of the Western Front called an informal - and unauthorized - truce. Front-line soldiers peacefully met in No Man's Land to share a precious pause in the carnage with a fleeting brotherhood. This film dramatizes one section as the French, British and German sides partake in the unique event, aware that their superiors will not tolerate its occurrence.
