February 5 – Film: “Peace, Propaganda and the Promised Land”

Documentary film about the US media and the control of information about the Palestinian/Israeli conflict. This has led to a bias toward the Israeli side.

A documentary film about the building, purpose, and hardship caused by the barrier wall surrounding the West Bank. President Carter considers this the best film on the subject.
