Tom Jackson traveled to Iraq with Voices in the Wilderness during the 1990s sanctions era. Out of his experience came “Greetings from Missile Street”, a documentary that shed light on the lives of ordinary Iraqis under crushing economic sanctions and “No Fly Zones”.

The documentary was a rare glimpse at a population otherwise blacked out of the US mainstream media.

On March 7, Tom will show “Missile Street” and facilitate discussion about Iraq under occupation today, including ideas for nonviolent action.
